POSITION HIGHLIGHTS:

ERSEA Specialist –Full-time position - The ERSEA Coordinator will maintain the eligibility, recruitment, enrollment, and selection system for the program. Provide direct assistance to families including conducting family interviews, to begin and complete the application process for Head Start/Early Head Start and CDE application process as needed. Bilingual Cantonese/English and/or Spanish/English required. Bachelor’s degree required, Social Services, Child Development or Business Administration preferred.

Family Advocate – Full-time and Part-time position available- The Family Advocate (FA) promotes family wellness and parent involvement in the Early Head Start/Head Start Programs while acting as a liaison between classroom and home settings in the areas of health and family services. Manages a caseload of 35-45 families. Bilingual Cantonese/English and/or Spanish/English required, two years working with children or family services. Bachelor's degree required, skilled in handling sensitive situations and the ability to support family needs.

Floating Resource Teacher – Full-time position – The Floating Resource Teacher provides coverage and support to teaching staff. They will provide consistent, responsive and respectful care to the children, and is also responsible for the safety, care, and development of all of the children. 1 year of teaching experience with young children and diverse populations. Child Development Associate Teacher's permit required.

Preschool Associate Teacher – Full-time position – The Associate Teacher assists in developing an engaging environment that reflects the cultural values and diversity of the children and families served. They provides consistent, responsive and respectful care to the children as a primary caregiver (teacher), and is also responsible for the safety, care, and supervision of all children in the classroom. Minimum of 1 year teaching experience with young children and diverse populations. Child Development Associate Teacher's permit required.

Preschool Lead Teacher – Full-time position – The Lead Teacher creates an environment to reflect the cultural values and diversity of the children and families served. They are also responsible for the implementation of lesson plans and classroom activities, as well as ongoing monitoring of the environment and interactions in the classroom. Minimum of 2 years of teaching experience with young children and diverse populations. Bachelor's degree in Early Childhood Education or related field and a Child Development Teacher's permit is required.

Resource Teacher – Full-time position – The Resource Teacher provides coverage and support to teaching staff. They will provide consistent, responsive and respectful care to the children, and is also responsible for the safety, care, and development of all of the children. 1 year of teaching experience with young children and diverse populations. Child Development Associate Teacher's permit required.

Substitute Teacher – Part-time position – The Substitute Teacher works with teachers following all established classroom practices and rules to ensure safe, secure, welcoming, fun-filled learning environments for Early Head Start/Head Start Children. The Substitute Teacher is required to be available between the hours of 7:30a.m-5:30p.m. Monday through Friday, to be on call and ready to come in as needed. Minimum of 6 units in Early Childhood Education required. Assistant Teacher’s permit required.

Substitute Teacher II – Part-time position – The Substitute Teacher works with teachers following all established classroom practices and rules to ensure safe, secure, welcoming, fun-filled learning environments for Early Head Start/Head Start Children. The Substitute Teacher II is required to be available between the hours of 7:30a.m-5:30p.m. Monday through Friday, to be on call and ready to come in as needed. Minimum of 12 units in Early Childhood Education required. Associate Teacher’s permit required.
